

I think all teenagers should read this books. I read them when I was about 14 and it scared me away from drugs and trying ouija boards for a long time. I did eventually try them, (ouija board once - with really scary results), and I did do drugs, but when I was older and don't now and haven't since forever. But I think that if I would have started younger, things very well could have turned out very differently. Had never read "Jay's Journal" so decided to revisit "Alice" again as well. Now as an adult "Alice" was just as sad, disturbing & powerful as it was 30+ years ago, and "Jay" as well. Not everyone's cup of tea I'm sure but both have strong messages, and I recommend reading them - not for titillation but as something to learn from.

i have one complaint: my box set came damaged. a corner of Ask Alice got stuck inside a tab or whatever inside the box, and I couldn't pull it nor Jay's Journal out because of it. Go Ask Alice kept me mesmerized throughout the scenes, and it's descriptions of the drug effects are very vivid and real.
