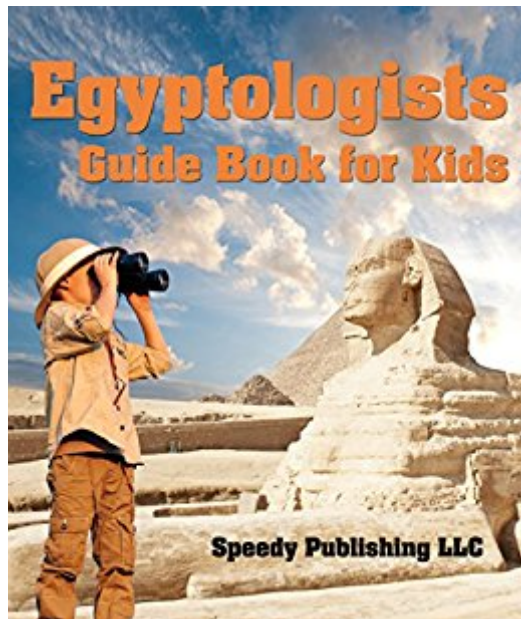




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Egyptologists Guide Book For Kids: Awesome Kids Travel Book

This is a great book to get kids started on learning about ancient cultures. Ancient Egypt is full of wonder and amazing human ingenuity. Young readers should be very interested in learning more after being introduced to a myriad of interesting and little known facts about Egypt. The pictures in this book are great. They highlight many of the things that make Egypt so very captivating. The facts are mostly interesting and some are not the usual when discussing this ancient culture. For example: which god the Egyptians credited with teaching men how to write, or why they associated Anubis with a jackal, or what the word Pharaoh actually means. My wife has her masters in ancient

history, so our children should be well versed in topics such as this by the time they're older. This will certainly be a go to in their early years of learning. Editorially speaking, this book seems to be very nicely laid out (in contrast to some of the others by this author). Text is readable, pictures and facts correspond well, and I thoroughly enjoyed it. ...but this was an amazingly difficult read with my Egyptology obsessed 5 year old. Egyptology Guild Book for Kids kinda left us wanting. We tried it a couple different times and he just couldn't get into the Cloud Reader edition. This might have been different in a printed form but digitally - it was hard to hold his attention. The photos are beautiful, large and amazingly clear. They seem to match the facts well. The Egypt Quick Facts... are in a slightly more logical order than many of the other Speedy Publishing titles but many still feel like they are oddly placed - defining words and giving origins might work out better when the word is first introduced and not in the middle of the book. Pronunciation guides for harder words might be a nice addition to the next edition, as well as a glossary would be AMAZING. Speedy Publishing does a FANTASTIC job with breathtaking photography but the facts always seem a little odd. I would recommend this book for maybe ages 6-10. Even with my kiddo LOVING Egypt, mummies, pyramids, and the like - it was difficult to keep his attention even with such a short book. There are great facts that you could expand upon for older kids who might want to do more in depth research, and there is just enough information to keep the younger children, like my son, interested.
