

This is a great book. This edition is a ripoff! The publisher has simply photocopied the nearly unintelligible original and claims that this was done to preserve its authenticity. In fact, it is nearly impossible to read. What is the point of a book if you can't read it? The text is washed out, blotchy and most characters are missing several parts making it extremely difficult to decipher the words. The entire book is like a 300 page "Captcha". It is painful. I would have returned it if the deadline to do so had not passed. As it is I will probably throw it in the trash (something I've never done with a book before). It really should not be sold. There must be a version of this important work that

someone has re-typeset. The cover is also stupid because it is the most un-Adirondack-like image I have ever encountered. What would posses someone to create such a terrible edition. Piece of crap. A major dis-service to the original author.

A number of articles written about the adventures of a Boston clergyman's hunting and fishing trips to the mountains were gathered into a book. His rhapsodic descriptions of the area and the healthful benefits of the "balsamic air" caught the imagination of thousands who longed for a change from the crowded city. Unfortunately there were no facilities to accommodate them and they were unprepared for the attacks of mosquitoes and other biting insects. So seriously disillusioned were they that they wanted to lynch MurrayNonetheless his accounts of various incidents are hilarious and entertaining.
