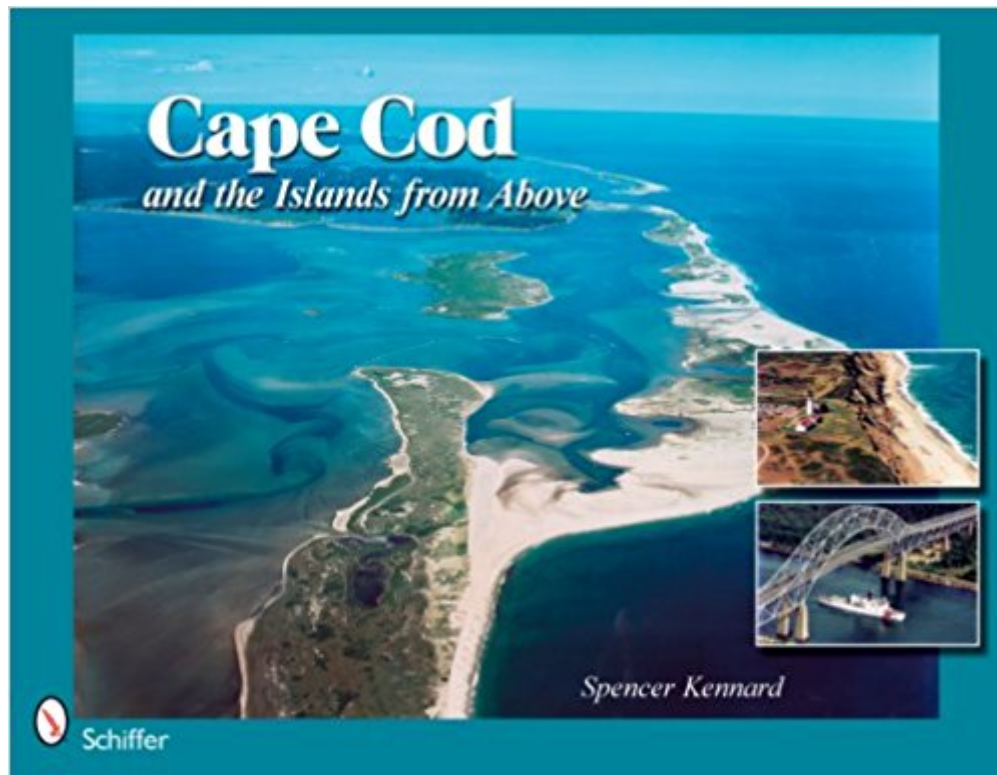




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Cape Cod & The Islands From Above: 50 Years Of Airviews
