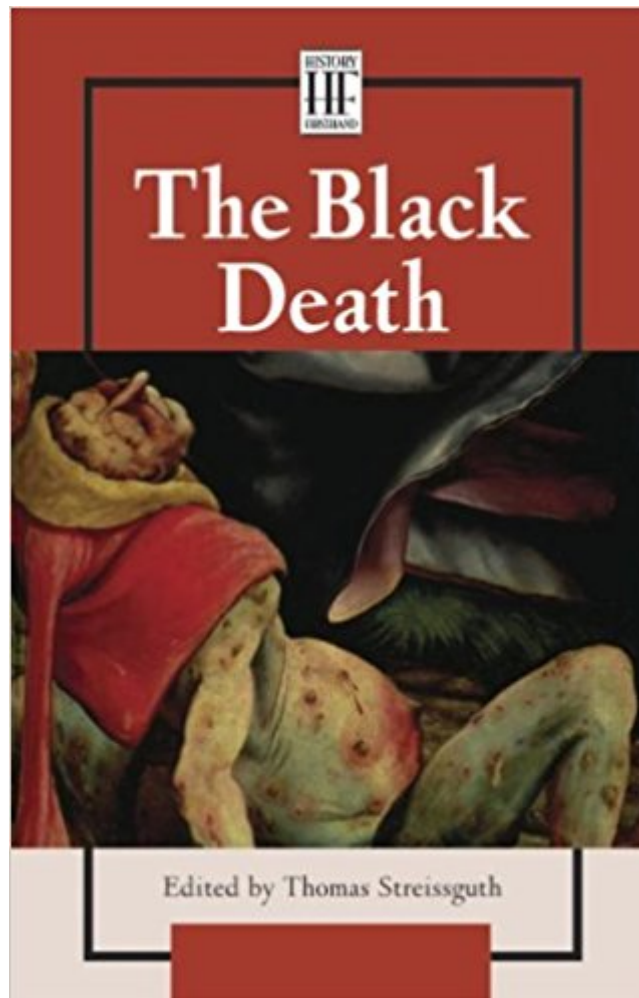

Grade 9 Up--The most terrifying pandemic disease experienced by humankind is explored through primary-source accounts, translated into modern English. While most works limit coverage to the 14th century, this volume also includes eyewitness reports from 430 B.C.E. Athens and the 6th-century Justinian's Plague as well as selections from Daniel Defoe's *A Journal of the Plague Year* and Samuel Pepys's diary account of the 1665 plague in London. A well-annotated table of contents and chapter prefaces provide contextual framework for the individual accounts. Chroniclers detail the horror and confusion caused by the bubonic plague, describing its symptoms, spread, treatments, supposed causes, and sociological effects. Black-and-white reproductions of a few contemporary woodcuts and etchings offer a visual glimpse into the world under discussion. Boxed sidebars help break up longer descriptions with brief excerpts from additional sources. The writing

styles and the similarity among several selections may make this treasure trove of firsthand experiences a dense companion to more general, more engagingly written descriptions. John M. Dunn's generously illustrated *Life during the Black Death* (Lucent, 2000) covers the great plagues of the 14th century, highlighting many aspects of the disease and its societal effects in a fascinating, readable style.--Ann G.
