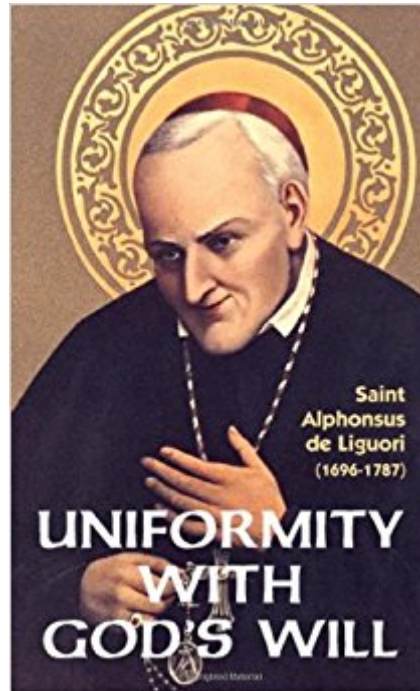




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Uniformity With God's Will

St. Alphonsus Liguori was born in 1696 to Neapolitan nobility at Marianella, Italy. He became a widely respected lawyer after completing law school at just sixteen, but later left his practice to give his salvation more attention. Alphonsus joined the Oratory of St. Philip Neri as a seminarian and was ordained in 1726, when he was thirty. The powerful homilies he gave were known for their profound ability to convert those who had fallen away from the faith. He also founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer and authored works such as The Glories of Mary, The True Spouse of Jesus Christ, Attaining Salvation, The Blessed Virgin Mary, Preparation for Death Abridged, What Will Hell Be Like?, The Twelve Steps to Holiness and Salvation, and The Way of the Cross. After being a bishop for over a decade, St. Alphonsus Liguori died on the first of August, 1787. He was canonized by Pope Gregory XVI in 1839 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1871. His feast is celebrated on August 1.

If you are serious about having a closer relationship with God, this book is for you. Though we have

a free will - and God does not want a bunch of robots obeying him, this book asserts that God delights in people who choose of their own free will to follow His will for them. Our plans are nice, but God's plans are better. When we put God's Will above our own, we are supporting God's best intentions for us and the world. We were all created for a purpose and God does have a wish or plan for us. It's up to us to seek it. This book proffers a logical, compelling and cogent argument for conforming our will to God's will. Whenever I now say the Lord's Prayer, I pause when I say "Thy will be done..." for emphasis since I now understand how important God's will is. Through this book I now more fully appreciate why Jesus included this essential maxim in His prayer. Even Jesus submitted to His Father's will.

A priest recommended this book, so I bought it. This book may be small, but its content is not. I read this book a little at a time to let everything soak in. Saint Alphonsus writes with such beautiful simplicity. In short, this book tells you that everything is God's will. Day by day we should accept all things that come our way as God's will. There are several bible verse quoted to help inspire. He also gives several scenarios to help the reader to better understand. When trying to live this out I feel more at peace. I would also recommend St. Alphonsus', "Glories of Mary".

This short treatise shows most convincingly that advanced degrees in theology are not necessary for salvation. Uniformity with God's will is the roadmap from earth to heaven with the fewest roadblocks. This GEM of a book should be required reading for all Christians seeking conviction in their faith. You will read it over and over.
