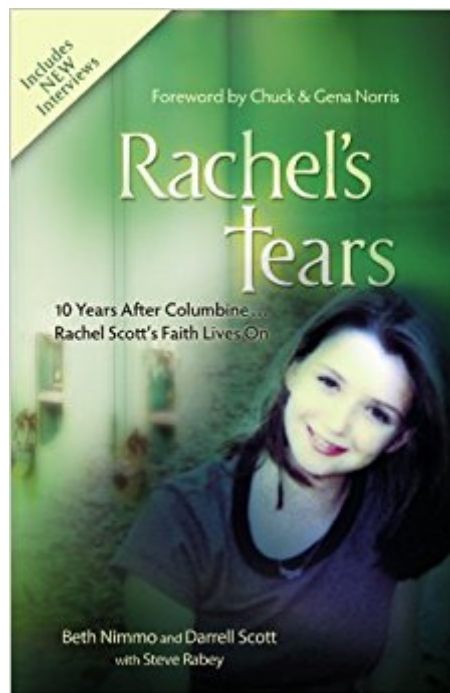




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Rachel's Tears: 10th Anniversary Edition: The Spiritual Journey Of Columbine Martyr Rachel Scott
