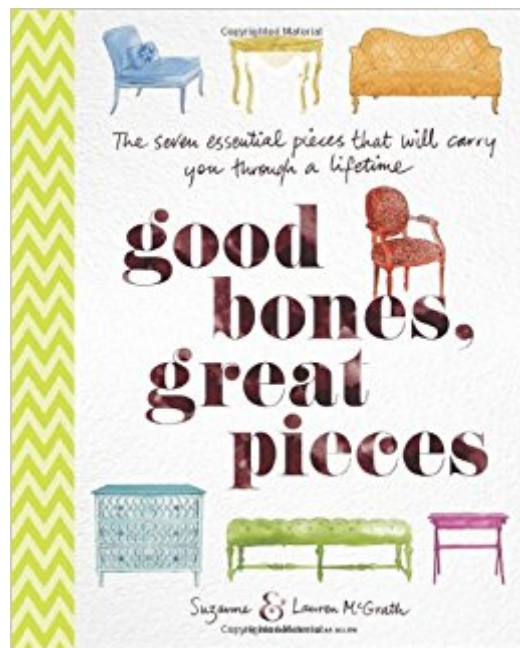




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Good Bones, Great Pieces: The Seven Essential Pieces That Will Carry You Through A Lifetime
