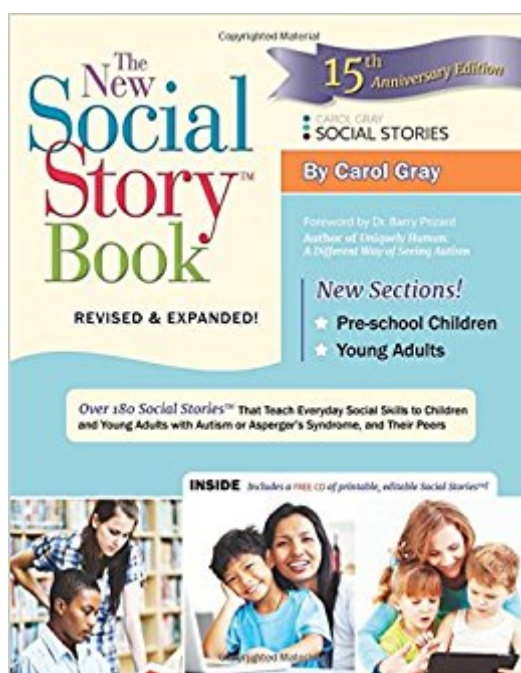

In 1991, Carol developed Social Stories, a strategy used worldwide with children with autism spectrum disorders (ASD). She has published several articles, chapters, and books addressing challenging issues ranging from how to teach social understanding and social skills; bullying; death and dying; loss and learning; and categorization and generalization. Carol is the recipient of several awards for her international contribution to the education and welfare of people with ASD.

Most stories are geared toward older kids. I didn't find many that I could use right now with my 4 year old. This book may be more helpful in the future.

It was OK. I was hoping for more adolescent story ideas, as it had stated on the cover it included these. Most of the ideas were for younger kids, though there were a few for the older student. I will probably use it mostly for my younger students, but continue to look for a book with ideas for older students.
