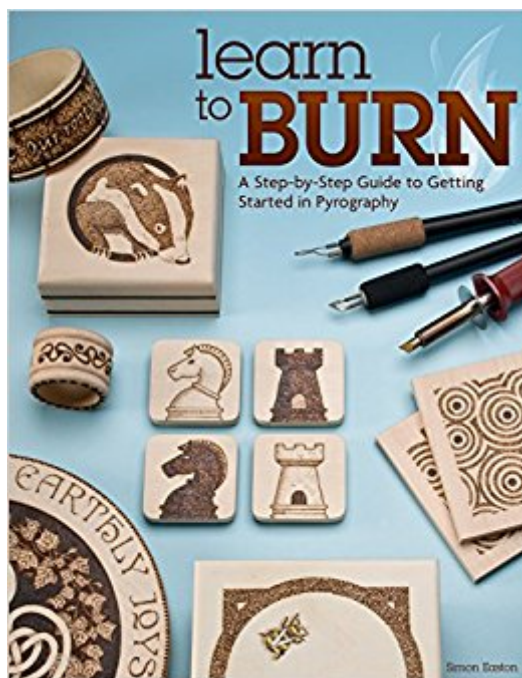

Simon Easton studied a BA (Hons) degree at Manchester Metropolitan University where he studied

woodturning, silversmithing and pewterware. His pewter napkin ring set was one of the MMU winners of the Pewter Live 1999 competition, and was displayed at Pewterers' Hall in London. He has won both a Precious Metals Bursary and a Grant from the Worshipful Company of Goldsmiths in order to produce design concepts that he had developed. The common theme in Simon's work was a decorative and textural feel, often rich in embellishment or pattern.

I was expecting a more comprehensive explanation of woodburning. Either it's super simple, or this book just doesn't cover what it should. Only about 2-3 pages at the beginning actually discuss the mechanics, the rest are just kitschy proposed projects. Not really about how to make art. Buy a ready made wooden object and burn a stencil on it! The worst part is that the instructions for each project are essentially the same: draw the design, move it over using transfer paper, do the outline, then shade. This book is a waste of money. You could probably find all the information contained in this book in an internet blog post for free.

Very good book for the beginning pyrographer. Si explains woodburners, use of nibs, safety, unique projects, and so much more. If you are a beginning woodburner I suggest you buy this book. Very well written and instructional.

This really is just a book of all the wood products you can buy at your local art or craft store, very little information about technique and such. Just project after project. I was hoping for more technique and effect type training.
