The Art of Fear is another terrific novel from Pamela Crane, an author with a growing backlist of taut psychological thrillers. Crane's latest offering departs from her previous work in that the plot is based on true events. The core of the plot is a tale of child exploitation that resonates through the generations of two families, framed as a drip-feed thriller with a clever final twist. For me, the standout features were the protagonist Ari Wilburn and the North Carolina setting. Here's Ari, the hard-bitten survivor and "retail girl", who's determined to uncover the corrosive secret of her past: "My life consisted of break room bitching over crumpled shirts fusty with old lady stink ..." I'm a sucker for the sheer diversity of American settings, and I was right there in the working poor suburbs of North Carolina, described with compelling authenticity. Although this is Pamela Crane at her darkest, the reader is rewarded with an uplifting ending and a promise of more good writing to come as Ari Wilburn takes a new turn in her life.

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
