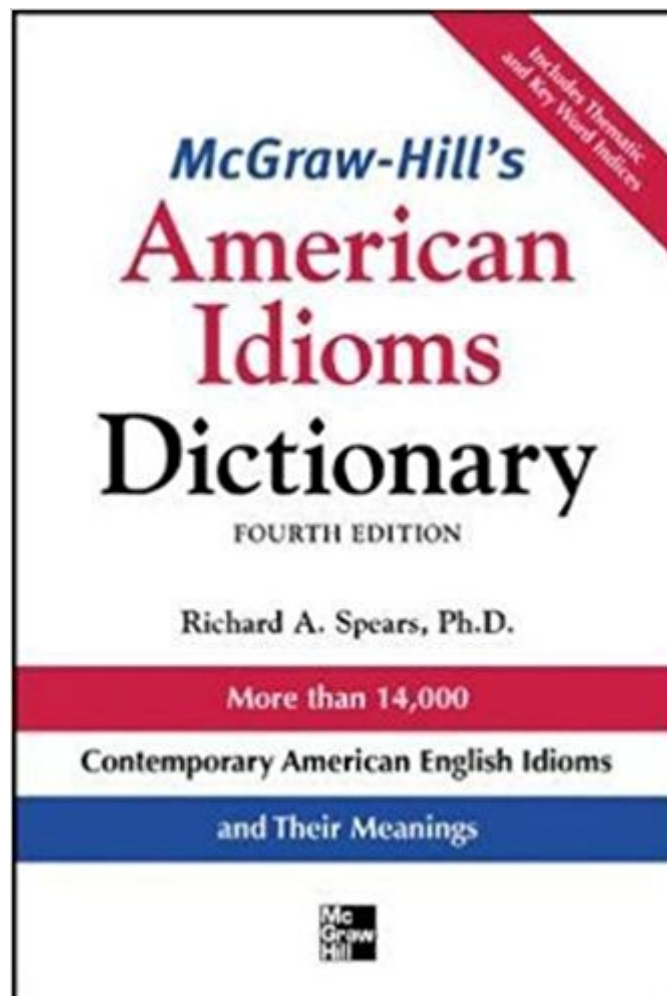

There is only "Dictionary" entry that leads to 'A'. I also expected to see Key word index keys to be somehow hyper links.

The key word index is especially helpful. I like that the definitions/explanations give a lot of

examples. While it has a large collection of idioms, it did not have some idioms that I looked up. Overall, I would recommend it.
