Influences from Trek, Star Wars, and even Babylon 5 are felt, but none are overwhelming. Instead the reader is treated to a synthesis of these classic franchises. At this point I am nearly 4/5 of the way through and the only real complaint I have is that as in many novels and films that include alien species (intelligent or not) the ones in this book are much too earthlike. I don't believe it detracts from my enjoyment much as even main stream authors usually don't bother delving into the differences in thought processes and reactions that would be a result from totally divergent evolutions. Other than that this book grabbed and held my interest and when I turn my Kindle off I immediately start thinking about when I can turn it back on, And I look forward to getting the next book in the series.
