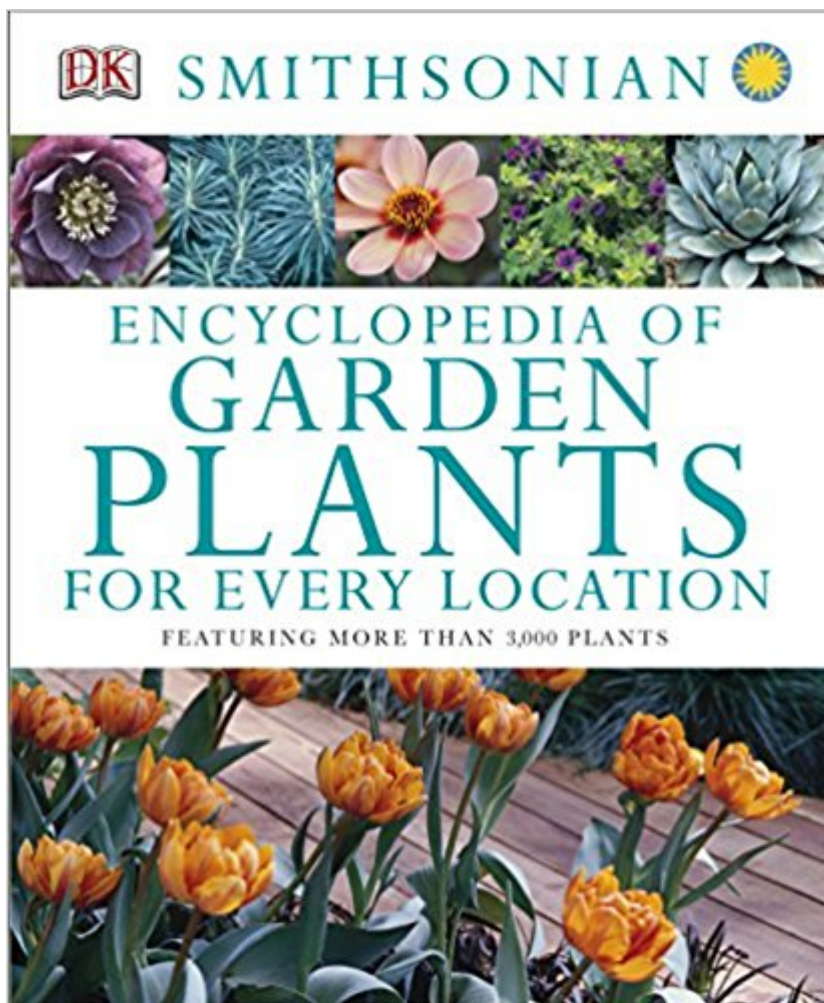

Useful book for recognizing some plants but far from comprehensive. Has the tendency to repeat some pictures in different sections rather than providing additional examples that would be useful. Further, as plants usage for gardening has evolved this has left gaps in the book. I use the book largely to recognize plants in public gardens that are not labeled that I happen to photograph. The book is not easy to follow for this purpose. Nevertheless, it is the best I have found. It would be more useful for choosing sets of garden plants to use in developing gardens in different climate zones in

the USA.

This is very similar to the Readers Digest version of many years ago, but updated. If you like to work in the outdoors, this is your plant book. I bought two, one's a gift.
