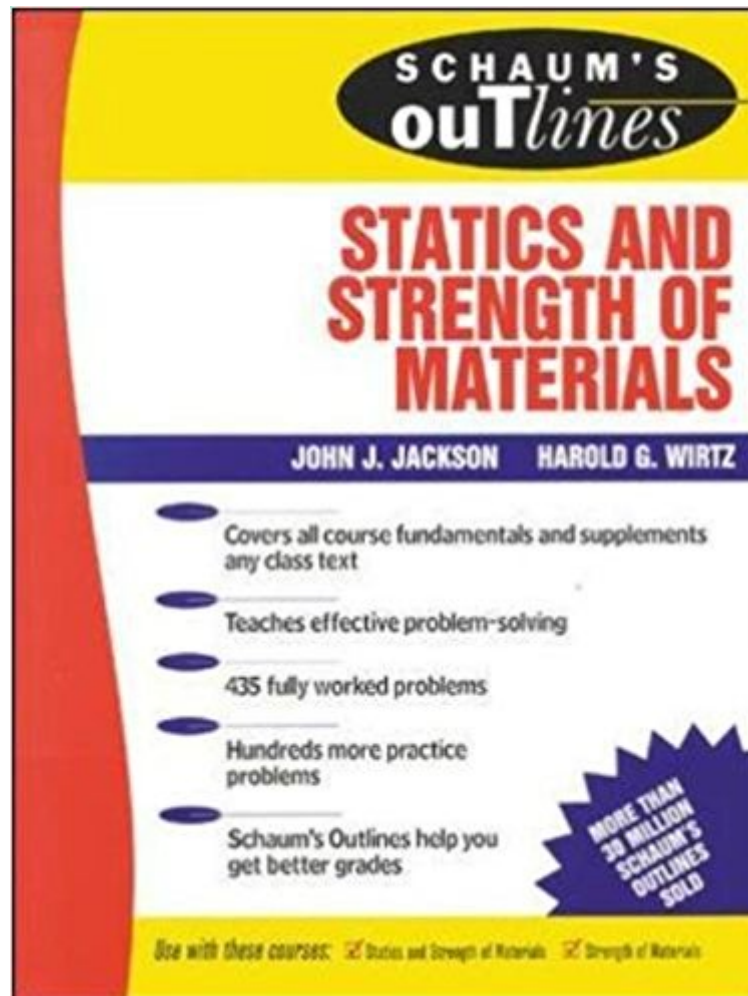




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Decent guide but not very helpful with 3D static problems.

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
