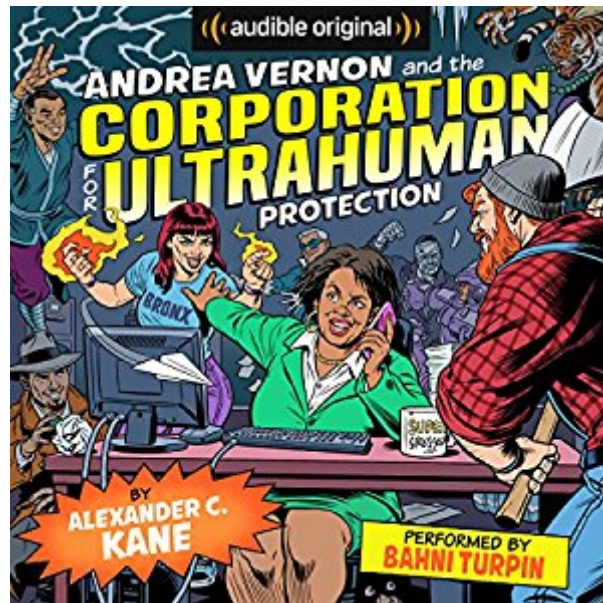

This book is totally unexpected. So funny, so original, so bizarre and yet totally realistic when it comes to the day to day drama and dangers of running a super hero agency! Kane is a fresh, exciting voice like no other on the market right now.

Alexander Kane's Andrea Vernon and the Corporation for Ultrahuman Protection is a hilarious take on a modern company that provides security and protection services for New York City, employing

superheros rather than police or security guards. It's very funny. The opening feels like something Douglas Adams would have written, and the daily experiences faced by the protagonist, Andrea, will feel all too familiar to anyone used to the corporate world (though most of us don't get to fight supervillians for our day jobs.) Highly recommended, especially in the audiobook format, where the narrator's vocal stylings make it feel more like a radio play than a novel.

I love this book! It's very Douglas Adams, but so distinct to New York the way Hitchhiker's Guide is so delightfully British. Andrea Vernon is such a great character, she even outshines the superheroes, who all have hilarious names and powers. This was my first Audible book, and the narrator was perfect. I can't wait to reread it when the hardcover book comes out, and I will definitely read anything Alexander C. Kane writes in the future.
