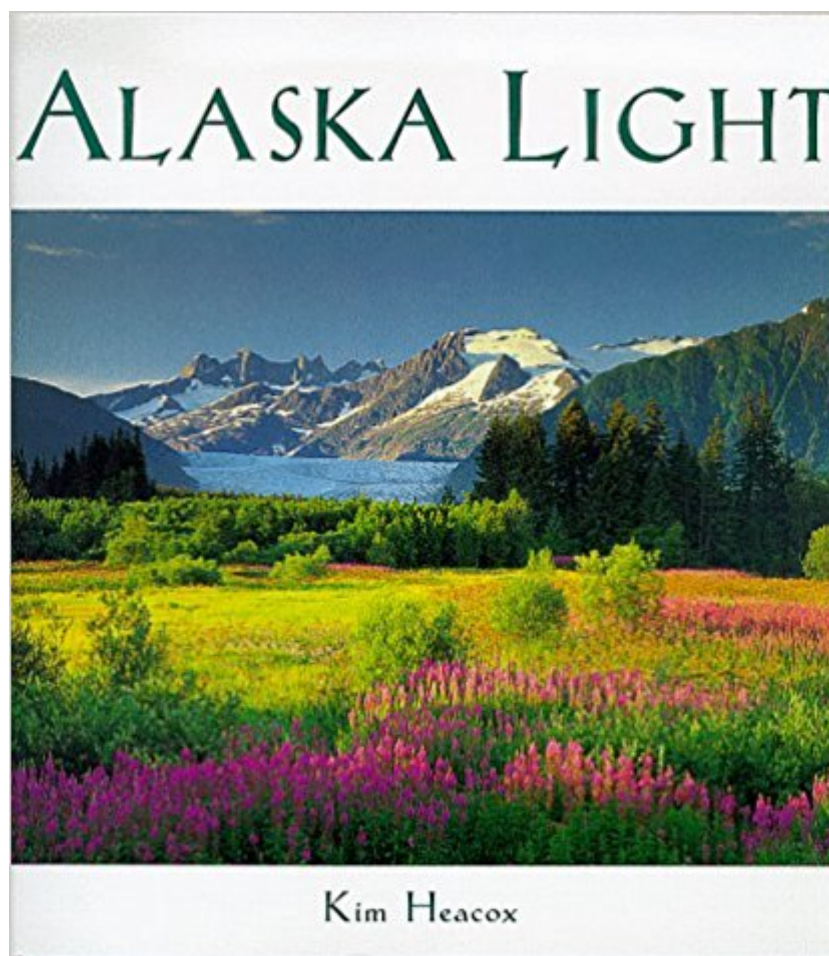

He first came to Alaska in 1979 and worked as a ranger in Glacier Bay, Denali, and Katmai National Park until 1985 when he reinvented himself as a freelance writer and photographer.
