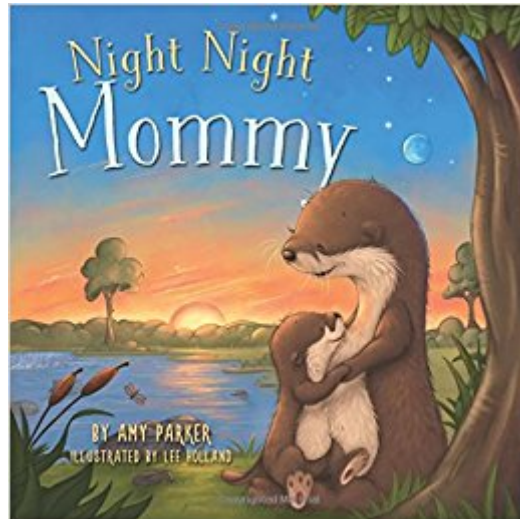

I bought this for my toddler, who now loves reading books "with" me at nap & bedtime (he turns the pages for me, and I read). It took a couple reads for him to enjoy this one, but once I had the realization that it might be because he knows me as "Mama" and not "Mommy", and changed out those words when I read it, it became a hit! He loves it now :) And for whatever reason, I suppose

the way it reads and how I say it, he finds the beginning "Oh Mommy (or Mama, for us)!" absolutely hilarious. He's also learned to put his hands together to pray during that part, and likes to point to the "night, night book" like the one we read ;) It's a cute story, really cute & well illustrated pictures, and toddler-approved. It's also nice if you have a bedtime routine, because it makes it relate-able.

This is cute book, with "laminated" pages. That's a good thing long-term. I just couldn't autograph it, not even with a marker. The writing wiped right off. The simple story is sweet and inspires "Mommy time." I gave the new parents each a book, one about being with and playing with Mommy, and one about being with and playing with Daddy.

I didn't realize this was a Christian book, so I loved the surprise of reading about their nighttime prayers. Very nice book, I know I will enjoy reading it to my baby over and over.

Story is told from little otter kiddo's voice. Starts with coming home from a fun time together, dinner, bath time, and getting ready for bed. Quite a sweet story.

~At twenty pages, this board book with a padded front cover targets children ages two to six years old. With no scary scenes, it is a nice story about a mother and child getting ready for bedtime. There is one reference to praying to God. Full page color illustrations of a meerkat and his mother cover the pages. Written in rhyme with some complicated wording, this tale involves a meerkat who has had a busy day. After dinner, he helps his mother clean the kitchen, takes a bubble bath, puts on his pajamas, does a dance, is read a book, prays to God, is sung to, and slowly drifts off to sleep, happy to have spent time with his mommy.
~Why ~Having a two-and-a-half-year-old granddaughter, her routine is similar to this book in that she has a bath, reading time, and then bed time. I like how she can relate to the story as her mother reads her the book, and she looks at the calming illustrations.
~ Why Not ~Those who do not have a personal relationship with God may not understand why it is necessary to spend time daily praying to God. Single fathers may shy away from a book that promotes only a mother putting a child to bed. Due to

some of three syllable words, it would be best to read it out loud to beginner readers.~ Who ~The author of over thirty books that have sold eight-hundred-thousand copies worldwide, Parker focuses on children, teens, and adults. Married, she and her husband have two sons. No information is given on the illustrator, Holland.~ Wish ~Because this book only shows a mother and child relationship, it should be noted there is a similar book for fathers too.~ Want ~If you are looking for a bonding book for a mother and child with pictures of meerkats, this is a nice choice. I love reading books with my son who is almost 2. He is a little rough still on books so board books are my favorite for now (this one even has the cushy padded cover!). Bedtime reading is something that I did often as a child so I'm hoping to do the same with him since I loved it so much. So a book about bedtime routines seems like a great fit! We recently got the opportunity to read both Night Night Mommy and Night Night Daddy. I'm glad we got to read both since I think they really pair well together. For this review, I'll focus on Night Night Mommy. While similar to Night Night Daddy, the bedtime routine uses different animals and this time they are sleeping in more of a house/cave type structure. The where of the sleeping is not emphasized as much as the other book, which uses a tent. The cadence of the story keeps everything moving along even if the words at times get a little long per page for my little guy. I imagine when he gets older it will be easier to finish a page before he's ready to move on to the next! I liked how the book made the bedtime routine fun and highlighted the two having a good end to the day together. The book includes bedtime prayers which is a nice addition. This was just a piece of the story, but definitely something that added to the Christian theme in it. Also, I liked the illustrations and felt that they were appealing to both kids as well as adults. Lastly, I really do wish there was a third book that followed a similar format but included both Mommy and Daddy into the story since I think that could be fun as well as relatable for a lot of kids too. I like, though, that these books could be used for single parent families or families with both parents in the house. I like both books and am glad to add them to our collection!
