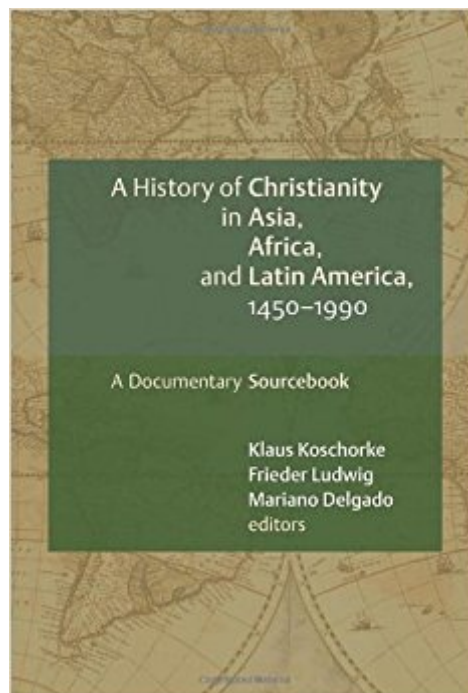




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# **A History Of Christianity In Asia, Africa, And Latin America, 1450-1990: A Documentary Sourcebook**
