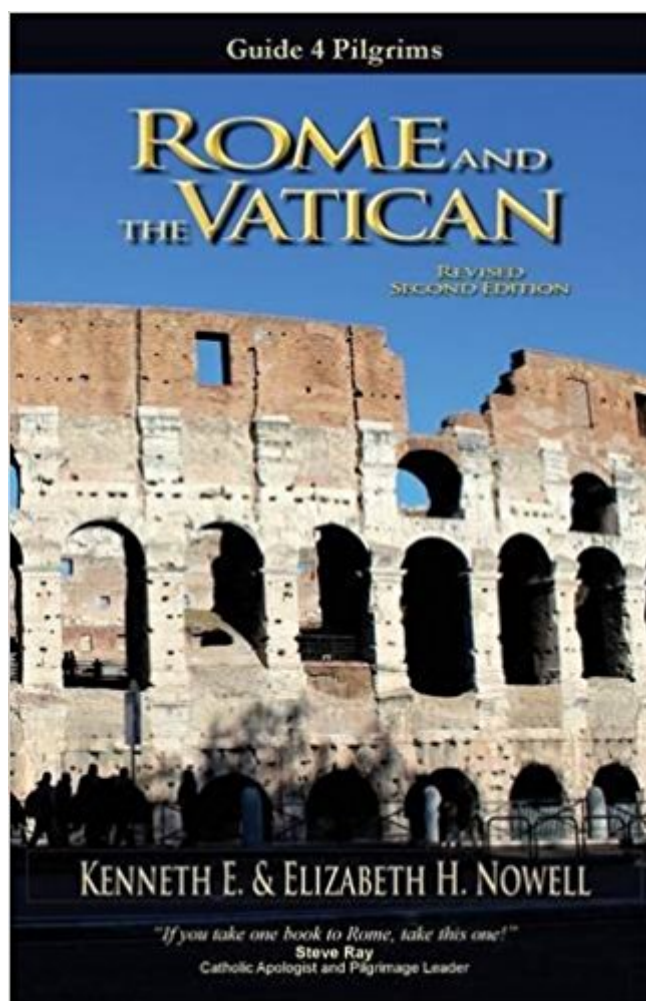


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Rome And The Vatican - Guide 4 Pilgrims

Three members of my family have been to Rome. I don't know if I will ever go, but I love history, religion, and geography. The Rome and Vatican Guide 4 Pilgrims is about all of that. The gorgeous photos are a travel log themselves. Kenneth and Elizabeth Nowell start by laying out

the beginning of Christianity. They include background of the apostles and Christian persecutors; the Popes, good and bad; papal trivia; the early saints that shaped Christianity; the artists who created lasting Church treasures, and the various churches and their histories. Even reading the tips for travelers gives me a glimpse into the culture— from dress codes and local idiosyncrasies to warnings of broken sidewalks. This book is unique for all it entails and is far, far more than just a book for travelers. It would make history, religion, art, and geography classes come alive. The book closes with a Scriptural and historical guide on the establishment of the Papacy and the Catholic Church— yes, even apologetics too.

"ROME and the VATICAN" is not only a great paperback guide for tourists but for those like me who love to learn quick facts about Catholic pilgrimages and the life of saints! It has pictures, recommendations, condensed historical facts and great tips. For example, if you want to visit St. Cecilia's place of birth in Trastevere, the book advises you that the church is tricky to spot because pilgrims must pass through an outer facade before entering the church's courtyard. The book contains pictures of the facade, the church and the places inside so you will spot it easily. Few books have so much information on this early saint that died around 230 AD that's why I was fascinated to read about her life and some of the people who she converted. "ROME and the VATICAN" has information on basic Italian so you can fend yourself while on your trip. It also gives you broad information of life in Rome: their dress codes, how to avoid the crowds, the country's national holidays, the famous piazzas, best restaurants, must see Vatican gardens and Roman architectural curiosities! Just reading it makes you want to book your flight to Italy and go, as the Italians would say... subito!

While I have never traveled to Rome, it's certainly a place I'd love to go someday and this book simply indulged that desire. It's not your typical travel book in its layout or tone, which makes it an interesting read. It provides background on the Christian history of Rome and has many practical tips throughout that are often written with a touch of whimsy. Inside are detailed walking tours for pilgrims and many interesting sites off-the-beaten path that are important to Christianity, which I did not know about. There are also all the practical things you would need for your trip like maps, transportation schedules, hours of key sites, important holidays and more. I highly recommend this for anyone traveling to Rome or even those, like me, who just dream of going there!
