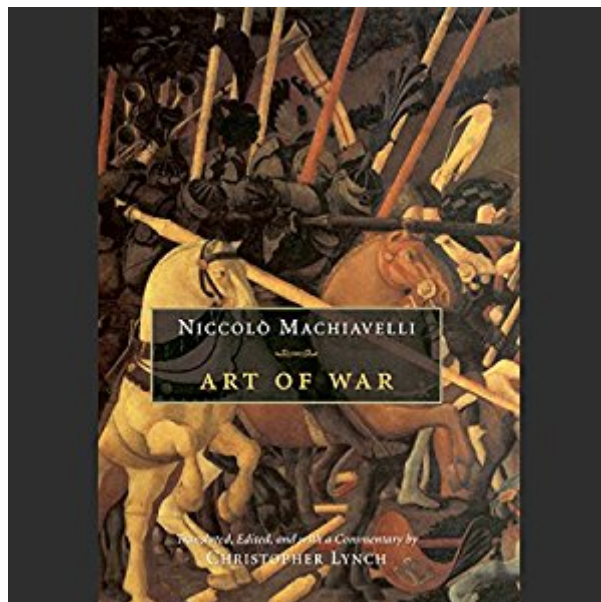

It's not an easy read because a lot of words are spelled differently but after a while it gets easier. If you want a copy of the Art of War written in our contemporary language you will have to look elsewhere. But if you want to read the same text that an Englishman would have read several hundred years ago then this is the text to get.
