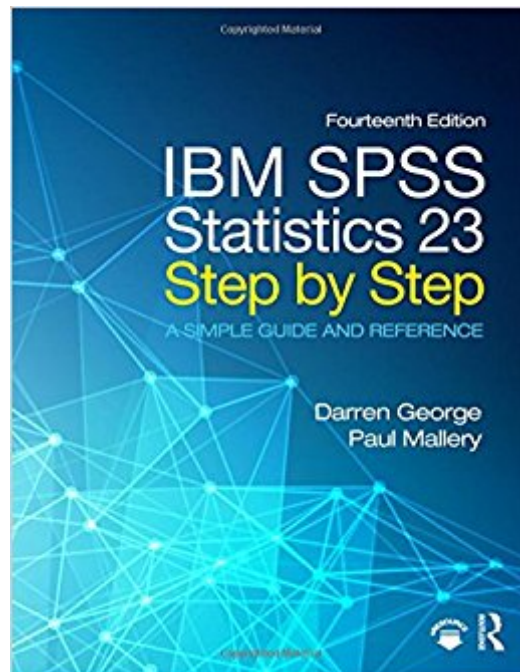

Getting data in the 'right' place and frame is incredibly important for me. Then I can do the statistical stuff required. This is the first and only 'stats' or 'programming' book I've ever read page-by-page, cover-to-cover. And I now go back and forth seamlessly between SPSS and R, even checking my coding in both by arriving at the same 'answers'. If you know stats, bypass Field's book to this one.
