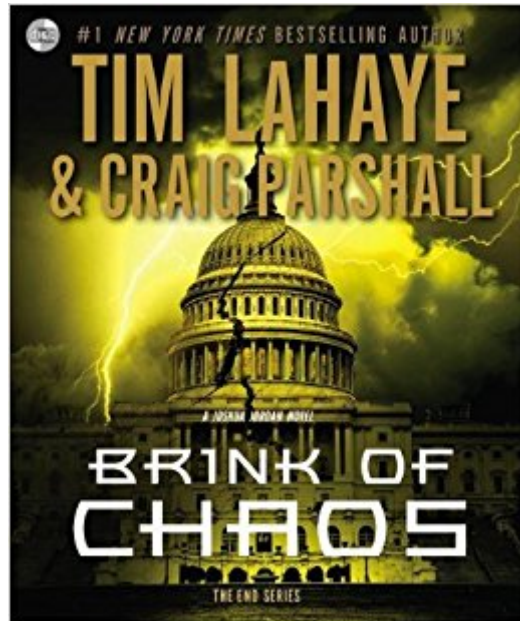

Synopsis

He is the coauthor of the record-shattering Left Behind series and is considered one of America's foremost authorities on biblical end-times prophecy. Craig Parshall serves as senior vice-president and general counsel for the National Religious Broadcasters and has authored seven bestselling suspense novels.

This story is one of corruption in politics, in our world, and among people. Very similar to what our world is like now. The main characters, the Jordan family, are fighting against corrupt people right up to the end, but they never waiver in their faith. This is a struggle happening to many people as they wait upon Jesus to return for his church. Along the way they share with others the story of Jesus coming to live among us, a perfect man who eventually reveals that he is the Son of God. Faith in Jesus and acceptance of him as our Lord and Savior is all it takes to be saved. A gift from God, through his mercy and grace, and not by anything we do. If we don't choose in time for Jesus' return for his church, there is still hope although we will have to live through tough times, as Satan attacks and tries to win more souls for himself. Jesus died for us on the cross, taking our sins upon himself so that we can have a relationship with God. Ideally we need to make our decision to accept Jesus and follow him before his return so that we don't have to live through he'll on earth before we can be with the Lord. This story tells a fictional story of what it will be like in those circumstances.

Wow! Loved the book and how the author brought everything together and tied up all the loose ends but still left himself a great way to continue the series. Can't say more without saying too much. Great book and series! Definitely recommend it.

I generally like this author though this book, like others I have read of LaHaye's writings, has so many characters that the reader needs to make a list to keep up with them all. I was bothered throughout this story also, that while the Jordans suffered greatly for their stance against having the BIDtag (a government required identification and tracking device) implanted on their own hands, they encouraged their two adult children to comply so that their son could enter law school and the daughter could work in the Pentagon. While that turned out to be helpful from time to time, it just seemed unlikely that parents willing to die rather than comply would encourage their children to take the convenient route and accept the mark.

Lahaye and Parshall have done it again. Elements of intrigue, Biblical truth, matters of faith and characters that you can either cheer for or against make this a pretty well rounded read. I love to investigate what the end might look like through the stories in this series and I believe any Christian might. I found it easy to become emotionally invested in these characters and I found my own heart being challenged to ask the questions about how I will handle things when the world gets closer to the end than it appears to be now.

It's okay. I really haven't gotten into these books like I did the Left behind series. I've pretty much forced myself to keep reading this book to see if it gets any better. I won't buy the next book in the series.
