

I am a retired teacher and while I never taught reading, I was the aide in two kindergarten classrooms and saw how it all starts with kids learning to read. I had no idea how it happened. They got to fourth grade and most could read. But seeing the struggling kids who couldn't remember letters and sounds, I could relate to these adults. Rob Schindler is amazingly creative with his teaching strategies.

I began this book on the recommendation of a friend who did not know that my mother had for 15 years in her retirement been a literacy tutor. She had sent me an article written about her as she was retiring from that endeavor. And she included notes written to her from a number of her students. Wow! She has been gone now seven years. But this book brought out in me a flood of emotions and a new appreciation of her accomplishments as a tutor. I laughed and cried through much of this book.

The touching story of a Chicago lawyer who in his quest to help his young son overcome reading difficulties helps a group of adults in a Chicago literacy program begin to learn to read. His methods and their struggles and successes are movingly, and at times, hilariously, told.

Told with a generous helping of Yiddish humor, this book will inspire any reader. Useful for any tutor but especially for literacy volunteers. The story is valuable more than pedantic offerings which lack the human dimensions.

This book is inspiring, moving and exceptionally well written. You will quickly find yourself caring about the characters in this book and achieving a greater understanding of adult illiteracy and the people affected by it.
