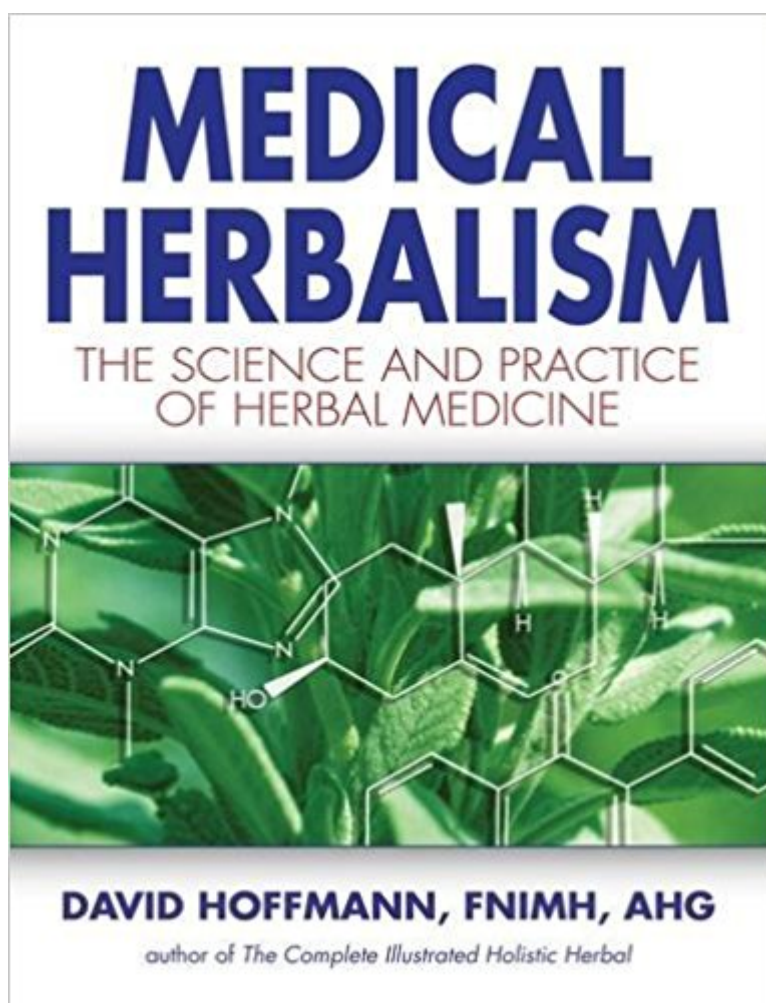

DAVID HOFFMANN, a Fellow of Britain's National Institute of Medical Herbalists, has been a clinical phytotherapist for more than twenty-five years. He started his herbal practice in Wales, continuing at the Findhorn community in Scotland, and has been practicing in California since 1986. A long time activist in the environmental and peace movements, he ran for parliament in Britain for the Green party in 1983. He is one of the founding members and a past president of the American

Herbalists Guild and is on the advisory boards of the American Botanical Council and HerbalGram. The author of seventeen books, including the highly regarded *The Complete Illustrated Holistic Herbal*, *An Elder's Herbal*, and *The Herbal Handbook*, Hoffmann teaches phytotherapy throughout the English-speaking world and is currently a faculty member of the California School of Herbal Studies. He is also a visiting faculty member at Bastyr University, the California Institute of Integral Studies, the National College of Phytotherapy, and the Rocky Mountain School of Botanical Studies.

This book has almost everything you'd want to know about herbs and how to use them medicinally. It has the chemical breakdown of all the herbs so you can really see what's going on, as well as listings for conditions and ways to treat them. I love this book, it's invaluable

Coming in at over 600 pgs., this text is a very workmanlike attempt to cover the field of medical herbalism. Every subarea is covered from classification to phytochemistry to pharmacology to preparation to treatment approaches. Hoffmann, too, is a died-in-the-wool herbalist who at every turn gives modern pharmacology its due but is also insistent that herbal medicine's complexity cannot be subsumed solely within the field of western medicine. His intellectual values are both traditional and progressive. Hoffmann also includes a detailed listing of references, a nice glossary,

and numerous appendi of use to the budding medical herbalist.

Brilliant book with all the serious Latin names!

This book is much more than i expected. It is full of scientific information on all the plants that it covers- and it is clearly a research based book-not a "tell you what i think" book. It has drawings of the molecular chains of some of the compounds. I like how everything is well organized into classes/families. There is so much interesting information in this book if you're detail-oriented. For example- you'll wonder why it is that one or two small changes in a molecule can cause such different reactions in the human brain. The section on alkaloids was especially interesting in this sense. this book makes me want to learn more about the chemistry of these substances

I purchased this book for two reasons. The first being the author David Hoffmann is the author of a book I have called The New Holistic Herbal. I found this book to very thorough in his relating herbal medicine to the human body. I highly recommend it. The second reason is I am taking an online course in Herbal Medicine. This book is recommended reading and I can say it is as thorough and detailed as the book mentioned above. David Hoffmann has a way of relating the science to the human body in a precise, well thought out way. There is a wealth of information and detail about all functions of the human body.How each herb is broken down into its components and what their interaction is with our makeup. He also can tell of drug interactions which is important for anyone on medication and wanting to self medicate. I can only speak highly of this book and while perhaps a little clinical for some it is well worth the purchase.
