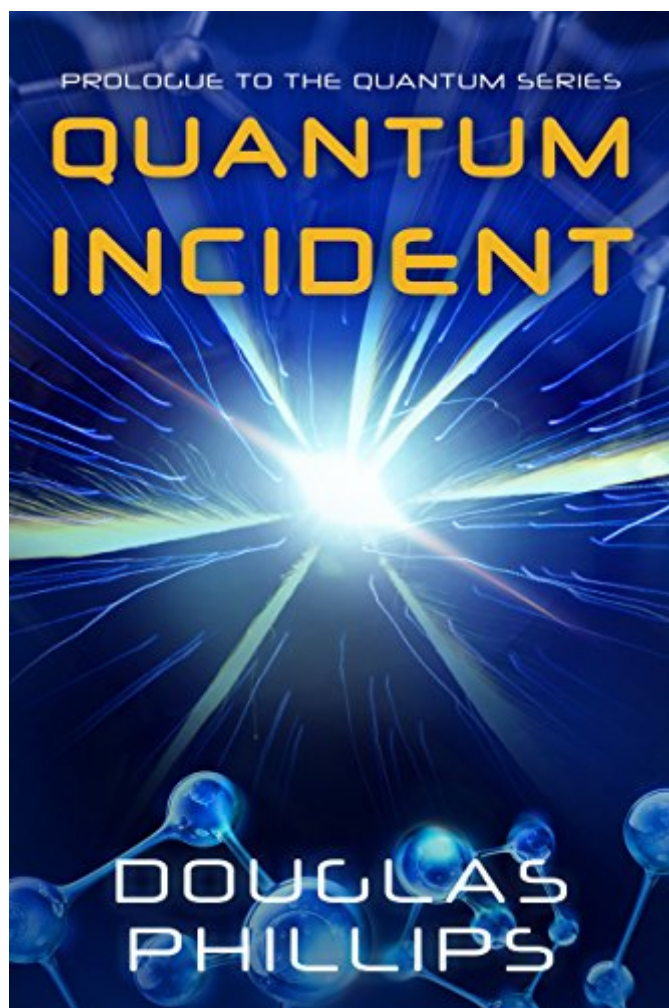

"Quantum Incident" (Quantum Series Book 0) is short Sci-Fi story by talented author Douglas Phillips that, in 5 chapters, hop-scotches centuries along an extended timeline and arrives at various points on the globe to tell the story of a mysterious object and human scientific advancement. Some parts of the story are intriguing, others seemed like filler, and some were very technical, but the story invites the reader to pursue the interesting story line in the main novels. I bought the first full Kindle novel in the series, "Quantum Space (Quantum Series Book 1)" to see where this storyline goes, and the early chapters are very interesting and look promising.
