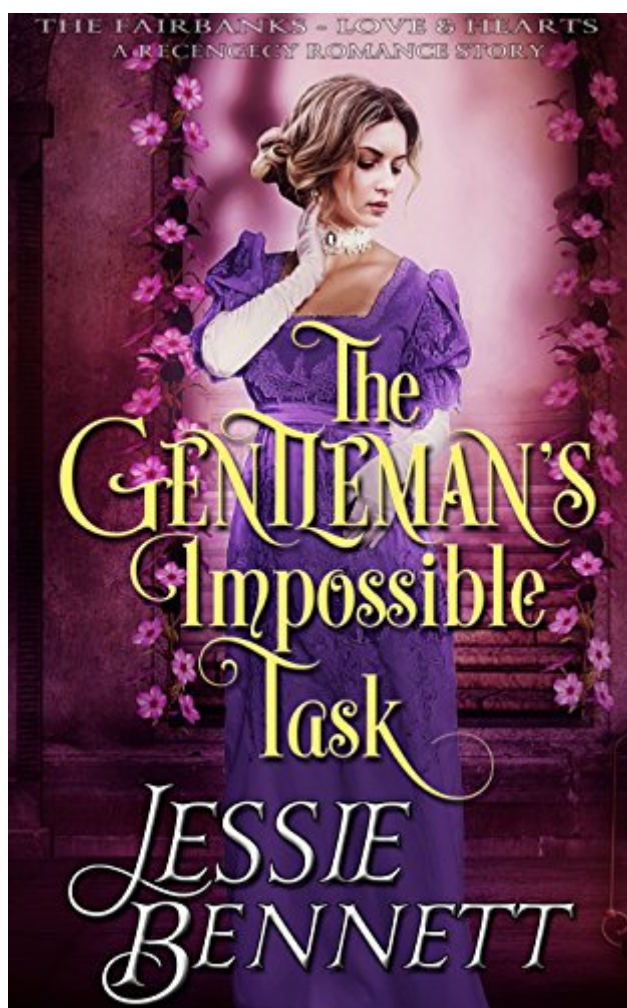

Murder, mystery, suspense and romance, *The Gentleman's Impossible Task* had it all. Ms. Bennett had me totally engrossed in this story from the prologue and kept me on the edge on my seat throughout. I could not put this book down and read it in an afternoon. It was a very enjoyable read. I also absolutely loved the way the epilogue brought the novel to a very satisfactory conclusion. The storyline was well written, Sam and Annette were well developed and likable characters and the plot was fast paced and intriguing. There were also twists and turns I never saw coming which really enhanced the story. Others have written about the plot so I won't. This novel is a must read for regency romance fans that like their romance with a bit of mystery and suspense. I highly recommend this book.

Jessie Bennett has done a neat trick with this book, writing a story that would be an excellent Regency Romance even without the murder mystery and at the same time writing a miser mystery tale that would work just as well without its Regency Romance trappings. Fans of either genre are in for a treat with *The Gentleman's Impossible Task*. Wonderful characters who are layered and complex, and experience real loss (the author does a great job in showing her heroine Annette's relationship with her husband before his murder) and real romance (the chemistry between Annette and Sam is beautifully done). That, together with the well written and wonderfully done plot that works so well on different levels, results in a truly enjoyable book. I'm happy to recommend it.

This perfect blend of romance and murder mystery kept me captivated until the end. It was touching to see Annette's deep love for her husband, and then her grief after his tragic death. I hoped she would have a chance to move past her loss. Sam Worthington was shown as a very capable, good and honorable gentleman. His fellow investigator Sam provided a perfect balance for his personality. Other supporting characters such as Simon and Jacobina added to complexity of the plot and made it more interesting. I loved the development of Annette's and Sam's relationship. They are cautious and unsure about the attraction between them, but at the end they cannot deny it. Annette has an additional challenge to overcome her loss, and allow herself a second chance at love. All this process is described beautifully. My only doubt was the short time Annette had to develop an attachment to another man. But extreme circumstances tend to speed up some events and decisions, so it worked at the end for me. And the epilogue is beautiful and heartwarming. Highly recommended for both romance and mystery lovers.
