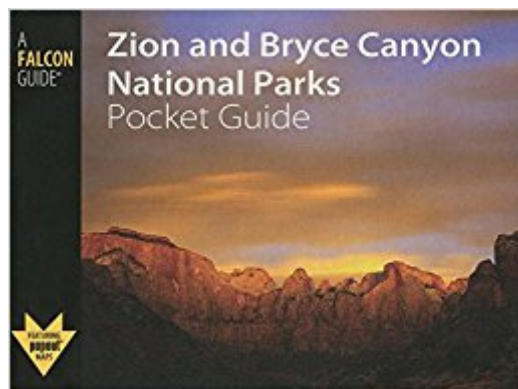




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# **Zion And Bryce Canyon National Parks Pocket Guide (Falcon Pocket Guides Series)**

A great help in orientation for five days visiting these two spectacular national parks and environs.

I was hoping for a guide to the park attractions but the book doesn't even get to that point until halfway through the 90 page hard-drive sized booklet and when it finally gets there, it spends only 16 pages on the topic. I didn't really care for descriptions of prairie dogs or the park history since I can get those easily from the visitor center and the limited amount of pages it has would have been better served as a quick menu to things we can do once we're in the park. Another problem with this guide book is that it is organized by topic instead of by park. For example, in the section on natural sites, it describes both Zion and Bryce attractions at the same time and you, the reader, are left to figure out which park attraction is being described. If there is one neat thing about this guidebook, it would be the small pop-out maps attached to the front and back covers, but they're not detailed enough. The park-provided maps have better detail in both the map itself and description of available attractions. Overall, you are going to be better off printing the park guides from the NPS site and supplementing it with some internet research, or getting another book about the area. I

have yet to go on my Southern Utah trip, and sadly, this book will not be going with me.

This little guide has a really handy map. A easy pocket guide to have in your backpack while hiking around this area.

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
