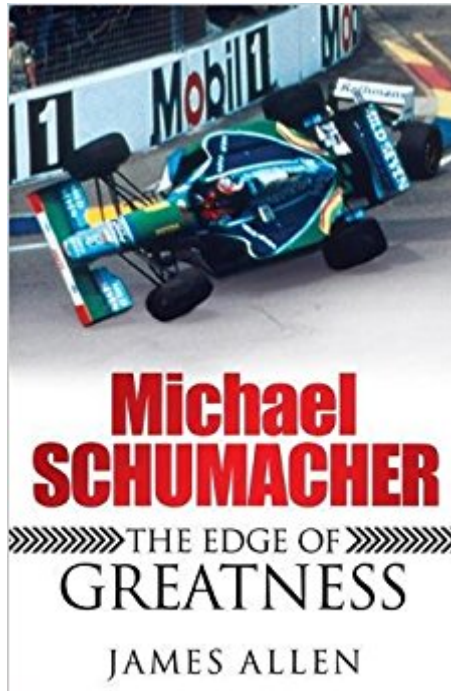

I expected more from James Allen to be honest. I read a lot from his web site and that is pretty decent for the most part but this has put me off buying any of his other stuff. I like some of his analysis points but for the most part it's just a boring chronology with very little flare and VERY uninspired writing.

Glorious victories and successive championships in the Ferrari dominating era by him simply made me a fan of him, the Prancing Horse and formula 1. This book revealed a comprehensive story, including the darker side of him that I have seldom heard of, of Michael Schumacher from a professional formula 1 journalist James Allen.
