

Synopsis

Women and Public Policy places a broad range of policy issues - from education and health care to economic equity and the criminal justice system - in historical context, discusses the formation and implementation of current policy, and explores public policy silences. In addition to featuring and analyzing new data, this third edition highlights issues of race, class, age, and ethnicity, showing how they intersect with gender in crucial ways. It includes greatly expanded coverage of reproductive issues with a new chapter devoted to the topic, looking comprehensively at contraception and abortion, the international gag rule, RU-486, the morning after pill, later-term abortion developments, and reproductive technologies. It showcases recent developments in all policy areas, from the impact of welfare reform on educational opportunities and child support enforcement to a discussion of Medicare and prescription drug coverage.
